	Increased hand-washing Implement measures for frequent washing with soap and water and/or alcohol-based hand sanitizer			
	Ensure social distancing Implement measures for minimizing extended close contact (less than 6 feet) and maintaining adequate distance between adults and/or students			
	Limit co-mingling, establish cohorts Conduct activities and routines in small groups that remain together over time to avoid co-mingling of students

	Protective equipment Establish guidelines for using face coverings, face shields, gloves, and/or protective barriers		
	Cleaning and disinfection Implement measures for increased cleaning and disinfection of classroom environment and materials, especially shared materials and high-touch surfaces		
	Health screening for symptoms of illness Establish procedures for frequent health checks and/or screenings and protocols when symptoms are detected

	Classroom schedules Create weekly and daily staff schedules to reflect hybrid learning plan	
	Desks, tables, and seating Arrange desks, tables, and seating to limit close contact between staff and/or students and to limit seat sharing	
	Environmental arrangement Arrange furniture and dividers to establish learning spaces that address instructional needs as well as health and safety precautions; remove materials that are difficult to clean	
	Limit shared materials Divide materials to limit sharing (e.g. individual PRT toy bins, separate reinforcers, separate independent work, individual writing and art materials, etc.); include a plan for materials from home	



	Classroom Environment, Staffing, and Set-Up

	Hygiene stations Establish hygiene stations around the classroom for increased cleaning and hygiene (e.g. sanitizer, cleaning spray, wipes, gloves, etc.)			
	1:1 staffing Implement measures to limit exposure for students receiving 1:1 support (i.e. same staff member assigned as 1:1 support daily)			
	Related service providers Create guidelines for related service providers to limit co-mingling and non-essential visits to the classroom (e.g. remote consultation options, working in cohorts, etc.)

	Arrival and departure Establish protocols for arrival and departure (e.g. staggered arrival and departure times, family drop-off, and/or busing plans)	
	Circle and large group Arrange seating to maintain physical distance, create guidelines for staff support, limit shared materials, and hand hygiene	
	Small group, rotations, and centers Arrange seating to maintain physical distance, establish cohorts, limit shared materials, and sanitize high-touch areas frequently	
	Transitions Arrange placement of individual visual schedules, establish protocols for physical distancing between staff and/or students and for waiting and lining up

	Toileting, hand hygiene, and self-care Establish increased hygiene measures, consider toileting schedules	
	Independent work Implement measures to limit shared materials and establish physical distancing

	Snack and mealtimes Implement measures to increase hand hygiene and limit sharing of foods; consider how staff can safely support students with feeding, AAC, etc.
